Sewer Problem? Step One: Call the City

If you suspect any sewer problems in your home, the first step is to call the City Office at 402.792.2212 during regular office hours (Monday thru Friday from 8:00 am - 5:00 pm), or call Public Works after hours at 402.432.1513 or 402.432.6018. The City will work to diagnose the problem to see if the issue is in the City's main sewer line or on your personal property's sewer line. By calling the City first, it will save time and money.

Protect your property:

Homeowners can prevent sewer back-ups by having a plumber install a back-flow valve on your home's lowest drain. This valve will ensure sewage will not be able to enter your home.
