- Grease Removers
- Oil-Based Paint
- Bleach based cleaners

Things that you cannot bring:

- Latex Paint
- Antifreeze
- Batteries
- Electronics & Computers
- Fertilizers
- Tires

Annual Dog License Reminder

City of Hickman Dog Licenses expire on April 1, 2016. Please purchase or renew your existing dog license number at the City Office by submitting licensing form and current rabies vaccine information. Every dog within the city limits is required to be licensed with current rabies vaccination on file with the City. (Municipal Code 3-204) 2016 Dog License forms are available on the City's website (Hickman.ne.gov) and at the City Office.

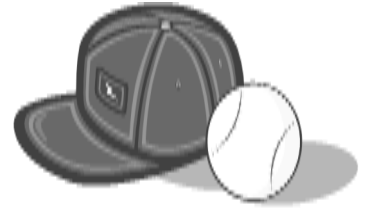

Hickman Utility Bill Reminders

As a friendly refresher on the City's Municipal Code (7-209) regarding the City's monthly utility bills:

- All City utility bills are due and payable monthly at the City Office.
- Bills can be paid by cash, check, MasterCard, or Visa Monday through Friday, 8:00am—5:00pm.
- An after hours drop box is available outside the City Office's front door for checks only.
- When using bank pay or mailing your utility bill, the City is not responsible for any delays in delivery time.
- Bills not paid by 5:00pm on the 20th of each month shall be deemed delinquent.
- Upon being deemed delinquent, there will be an amount added to the bill equal to 10% of the total original bill due.
