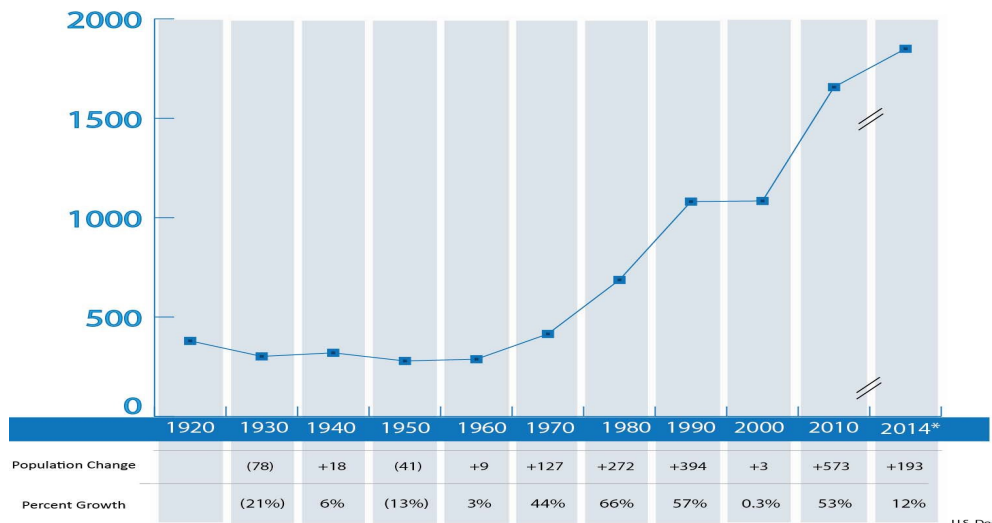

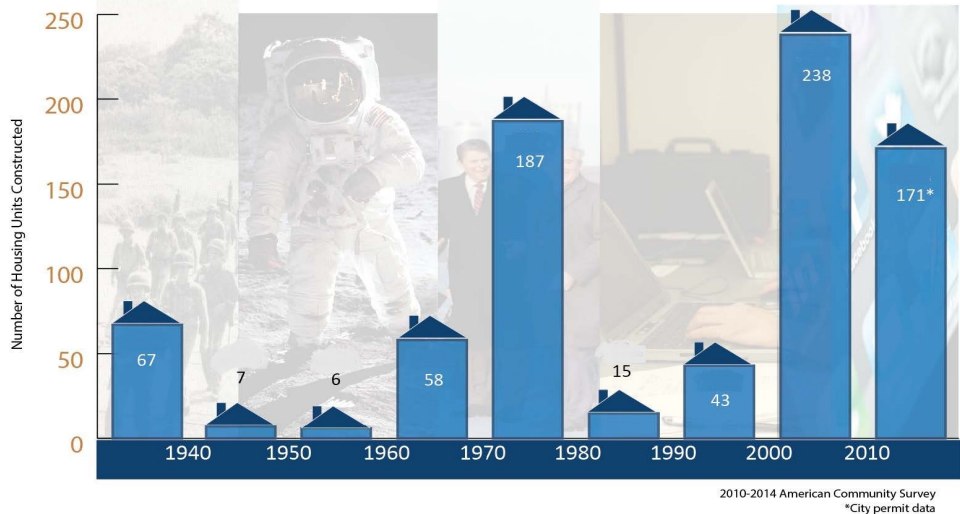

Hickman Recycling Center

The City's Recycling Facility is located on 2nd Street West of the Railroad Tracks in Hickman's Main Park, Southwest of the Legion Baseball Field. Items you can recycle are:

- Tin and Aluminum Cans
- Plastics - #1 through # 5
- Newspapers/ Mixed Paper/Cardboard
- All Glass - Clear or Colored Do your part in helping keep the environment clean.



Important Brush Pile Information

Please be aware the brush pile **cannot** accept **any** trash, lumber or bags. Items allowed in the Brush Pile are limited to tree limbs, shrubs, leaves, & grass clippings.

Residents utilizing the brush pile should be aware that if prohibited items are found, the Lincoln-Lancaster County Health Department could revoke the City's open burn permit resulting in the permanent closing of the public brush pile. Brush Pile facility keys are available for check out by City of Hickman residents at the City Office, 114 Locust Street. Keys can be checked out overnight (24 hrs.) and be returned to the drop box in front of the City Office or the front desk.
