City of Hickman Snow Removal Policy

The City Public Works Department plows the City Streets/Trails after an accumulation of three or more inches of snow in the following order:

1. Chestnut Street (68th Street)
2. Hickman Road (7th Street)
3. Downtown Business District
4. Residential Streets
5. Residential Alleys
6. City Owned Trails/Sidewalks



To ease snow removal, please remember to remove your vehicle(s) from the City Streets as soon as possible.

Resident Responsibility:

City sidewalks should be cleared of snow and debris within 24 hours after a storm.
