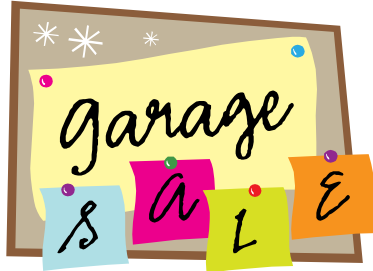
## A Message from the Mayor Doug Hanson

The first difficult task was appointing someone to fill the Hickman City Council vacancy for the unexpired term ending December 2016. I wanted to appoint an individual that could "hit the ground running" and someone that knew the Hickman community. I am pleased a number of very well qualified and experienced men and women submitted their names for consideration, making my decision even more difficult.

I am pleased to report that on June 10<sup>th</sup>, Justina "Tina" Ziemann was affirmed by the Hickman City Council to serve as your new City Council Member. Tina officially took office on June 24<sup>th</sup>. Of all the applications received, Tina has served on the Hickman Planning Commission the longest (since 2005).
