July 4th from 10:00am-11:59pm

## ATV Reminders

An all-terrain vehicle, utility-transport vehicle and mini-pickup may be operated only between the hours of sunrise and sunset

The headlight and taillight of the vehicle shall be fully operable and visible

The vehicle shall be equipped with an electric strobe/flashing beacon mounted on the top of the vehicle or a bicycle safety flag which extends not less than five feet above ground attached to the rear of such vehicle

The Vehicle shall have a visible, operational brake light system

Driver must have a valid Class O operator's license or a farm permit

Must wear a helmet or hard hat

Have liability insurance coverage for the all terrain vehicle
