Illegal Dumping of Trash on Properties

There has been an increase in the number of complaints regarding the illegal dumping of furniture, trash, and grass clippings on other people's property and open fields.

City of Hickman Municipal Code Section 3-114 Trash states:

It shall be unlawful for any person to willfully, maliciously or negligently place or throw upon the premises of another any filth, garbage, leaves, papers or other matter to the annoyance of the owner or occupant thereon.

If you are in need of a place to put your clippings and branches, Brush Facility Keys are available for check out by Hickman residents at the City Office. Keys can be checked out overnight and returned to the drop box in front of the City Office or returned to the front desk the next day. Items allowed in the Brush Pile Facility are limited to the following:

- Tree Limbs
- Shrubs
- Leaves
- Grass Clippings

The Brush Facility cannot accept **any** trash, lumber or bags.

Lost keys are subject to a \$25.00 Replacement fee


